<u>Position Overview:</u> The Facilitator will ensure the health, safety, and well-being of all children while instructing children in all activities including three primary components: Academics, Enrichment, and Recreation as outlined by the Site Director.

- Serving as a positive role model and upholding professional behavior
- Participating in mandatory training and staff development activities outside of program Hours
- Collecting and submitting data in a timely manner including: snupper numbers, attendance, recreation times, homework completion and personal time sheets

- Successful experience working with young people in an organized programmatic setting
