Students will learn about American history and government, and practice their English language skills as they prepare for the civics, and reading, writing, and speaking portions of the U.S. Citizenship exam. By the end of the course, students will be familiar with the structure of the Citizenship interview, and will be more prepared for the civics and English portions of the exam.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EXAM

- Be at least 18 years old when you submit Form N-400, Application for Naturalization.
- Show you have been a lawfully admitted permanent resident of the United States for at least five years.
